By-Law Update

Ralph mentioned the work that was taken by several members to update the bylaws. This was needed because the last update was completed in 1980. A Board Meeting was called on Saturday November 5<sup>th</sup> to review and unanimously approve the bylaws.

Stickers, Coasters

It was also decided to order T-shirts for the Brushing Day. They will be distributed at the evening dinner.

From the Snow Council, there was discussion on the laminated maps with a decision to order 15 maps.
