AWSC Report

Highlights provided by Ralph, these are from Pat's attendance at the Langlade County Snow Council Meeting. As of 12/31/22 there were 23,937 trail passes sold, over 5,000 members and 150 commercial members. American Income Life Insurance will be sending our mailings. They have reinstated their \$3,000 death benefit to members. Since 1995 they have paid out \$501,000 in 322 claims. The AWSC Convention will be in Green Bay at the Radisson March 24–26. Register on the AWSC Site. There are 42 applications for 13 scholarships. An award was developed for the Junior Groomer 18 -29 y.o. The regular Groomer Award is for 30 and over. Encouraged clubs to get involved. Unanimous decision by Directors and Representative to increase the supplemental first payment to 75% by September 15<sup>th</sup> of each year and final payment by December 1. The Rec Council was bringing this to the DNR.
