Equipment update

Following the Board Meeting, the decision was made to continue the process to replace the Tucker from Armstrong Creek. Wayne will be proceeding with the financial requests. In this process, the borrowing of \$60,000 will be against the 2021 Tucker with the potential financing of the full amount due. It was discussed that the Club from Apple Creek is interested in the purchase of our current tucker. The existing tucker needs to be appraised to obtain a selling price. The Fendt will be held on to for at least another year and Ralph is checking on what type of extended warranty could be obtained. The drags will need blades replaced and this could be done at a maintenance day in fall.

Bridge Update

Ralph was in contact with Terry Lukas from the County Board, and it was stated the same contractor will be involved with the replacement of the bridges and they all could be done this summer.
